

Proposed Rules and Regulations
El Campo Farmer's Market

El Campo Farmer's Market will be held on the 1st Saturday of the month (May, June, and August) located at Alamo Park. Hours for the market are 9 a.m. through 1 pm. Below are general guidelines for participants:

- Vendor space is 10' x10'
- There is no fee associated with space
- Registration is required for space
- Vendors are responsible for their own table, tents, etc.
- NO garage sale items, silly spray, confetti, used clothing, items violent or indecent in nature
- Vendors are required to remain for full duration of the market
- Upon exiting, vendors must clear their space of trash and other debris

Sales Guidelines:

- If selling a craft item, sales tax regulations do apply.
- Sales tax permit is required with registration if selling crafts.
- Fruits and vegetables shall be sold in a fresh, whole and intact, unprocessed or canned/preserved state.
- Honey and syrup must be acquired only from an approved source in a container bearing an approved label.
- Canned, preserved and baked items must adhere to the Texas Cottage Food Law. All items must be labeled properly. Vendors must obtain a Food Handler's Permit.
