A complete application must include:

- Application Fee: \$ 250.00

- Site Plan
- · Other necessary information (maps, drawings, pictures, etc.) to further explain the project.

The City Council, upon recommendation of the Planning and Zoning commission, may by ordinance grant a special permit and may impose appropriate conditions and safeguards, including a specified period of time for the permit, to protect the comprehensive plan and to conserve and protect property and property values in the neighborhood.

The City's staff may require other information and data for specific required plans. Approval of a required plan may establish conditions for construction based upon such information.
